This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students across all grades achieving a 'C' standard or above in mathematics from 68% in Semester One 2016 to 75% by Semester 2, 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students across all grades achieving benchmarks in reading from 61% in 2016 to 75% in 2017.
- Develop staff capacity to improve student performance and participation in STEM.
- Continue to strengthen Pre-Prep transition programs and partnerships in 2017.

Our initiatives include

- Examine current pedagogy and student outcomes in numeracy and reading to develop a clear and consistent plan that ensures improvement of teaching and learning outcomes.
- Create a culture that promotes participation in STEM.
- Continue developing Prep transition programs and procedures to assist with a smooth and successful transition to school.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing a teacher at 0.5FTE to reduce class sizes and increase targeted, individualised teaching and learning.	\$38,000
Implementing Early Start initiative (teacher release).	\$1200
Funding an onsite playgroup which includes parent and community education programs.	\$7700
Enrolling selected students in the online Project Booster 'Solve It' (numeracy) to increase the number of students in U2B.	\$3135
Building teacher knowledge and skill-sets to effectively use STEM initiatives to make contributions to the school and wider community.	\$1500
Funding teacher release for a selected teacher to become a 'Reading Champion'.	\$1500



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
