This funding will be used to

- Curriculum – Implement P-6 Curriculum model and all 8 learning areas of Australian Curriculum.
- Collaboration – Improve student and staff well-being and student behaviour.
- Comprehension – Implement strategies to ensure 85% of all students are at or above Regional Reading benchmarks.

Our initiatives include

- Improve student achievement in Reading and ensure 85% of students are achieving Regional Reading benchmarks.
- Implement Spelling Mastery.
- Delivery of *Read it again* for students at risk or below Regional Reading benchmark.
- Improve student behaviour and ensure consistency of practice when dealing with behaviour.
- Increase student and staff well-being through collaboration model and build teacher capability in dealing with difficult behaviour.
- Build staff capability to deliver the P-6 Curriculum Model to align with implementing all eight learning areas of the Australian Curriculum.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide teacher aide to deliver *Read it again* and Spelling Mastery. (\$35,160)
- Spelling Mastery implementation. (\$3,650)
- Whole-school approach to Reading and Comprehension. (\$3,000)
- Build teacher capability to deliver P-6 Curriculum Model. (\$6,000)
- Implement and delivery of student and staff well-being programs. (\$3,000)
